Background:

Per USDA Regulations - 7 CFR 245.5(a)(1)(viii); 7 CFR Part 245.6(a)(2);DR 4300-003 Section 5(c); FNS Instruction 113-1, Section IX and Section XI:

NDS (Nondiscrimination Statement): All SFA's websites include the appropriate USDA Nondiscrimination Statement (NDS) in English and Spanish. District's/School's website must have the most recent NDS statement.

Option A: Individual webpage is created for the NDS, and the NDS webpage is linked:

- 1. If the website has a Nutritional page, then the link to the NDS must be on Nutrition's Main Page
 - Link to individual NDS webpage
- 2. If the website does NOT have a Nutritional page, then the link to the NDS must be on the Main Landing Page
 - Link to individual NDS webpage

Option B: Language on page.

- 1. If the website has a Nutritional page, then the NDS language must be on Nutrition's Main Page
 - The NDS language is at the bottom of the Nutrition Main Page
- 2. If the website does NOT have a Nutritional page, then the NDS must be on the Main Landing Page
 - The NDS language is at the bottom of the Main Page

LEP / ADA (Accessibility Assistance) Tagline: All SFA's websites include the appropriate **LEP / ADA (Accessibility Assistance)** Tagline, in non-english languages and the phone number to the **SFA.**

Option A: Individual webpage is created for the LEP / ADA (Accessibility Assistance) Tagline and the LEP / ADA (Accessibility Assistance) Tagline webpage is linked:

- 1. If the website has a Nutritional page, then the link to the LEP / ADA LEP / ADA (Accessibility Assistance)

 Tagline must be on Nutrition's Main Page
 - o Link to individual LEP / ADA (Accessibility Assistance) Tagline webpage
- 2. If the website does NOT have a Nutritional page, then the link to the LEP / ADA (Accessibility Assistance)
 Tagline must be on the Main Landing Page
 - Link to individual LEP / ADA (Accessibility Assistance) Tagline webpage

Option B: Language on page.

- 1. If the website has a Nutritional page, then the LEP / ADA (Accessibility Assistance) Tagline language must be on Nutrition's Main Page
 - o The LEP / ADA (Accessibility Assistance) Tagline language is at the bottom of the Nutrition Main Page
- 2. If the website does NOT have a Nutritional page, then the LEP / ADA (Accessibility Assistance) Tagline must be on the Main Landing Page
 - o The NDS language is at the bottom of the Nutrition Main Page



Then placed the links to each of those webpages at the bottom of all of our Nutrition related webpages.


Screenshot of SSWB's Main Nutrition "Splash Page":
